Due to the fact that we now want to focus on vocabulary expansion *as well as* 100% spelling accuracy, we've introduced a new spelling format. In order to keep you on your toes, I've tried to include some words which appeared in last term's tests. Some of the words will work beautifully in your Tudor writing too, so try and weave them in where appropriate. Each week you will receive a mark out of 8. An ideal time to investigate your words each week would be 20 - 25 minutes.

Your weekly test will include the following types of question:

- 2 spellings from the words in the list
- 4 synonym replacement questions
- 2 of the words will need to be written *correctly* within a sentence

Your rewards will be:

- 8/8 = 3 signatures
- 7/8 = 2 signatures
- 6/8 = 1 signature

If you receive FULL marks in each of the 11 tests, then you will receive 15 signatures!
