Due to the fact that we now want to focus on vocabulary expansion *as well as* 100% spelling accuracy, we've introduced a new spelling format. In order to keep you on your toes, I've tried to include some words which appeared in last term's tests. Each week you will receive a mark out of 8. An ideal time to investigate your words each week would be 20 - 25 minutes. You'll also need to investigate the word types - are they verbs, adverbs, nouns, adjectives etc?

Your weekly test will include the following types of question:

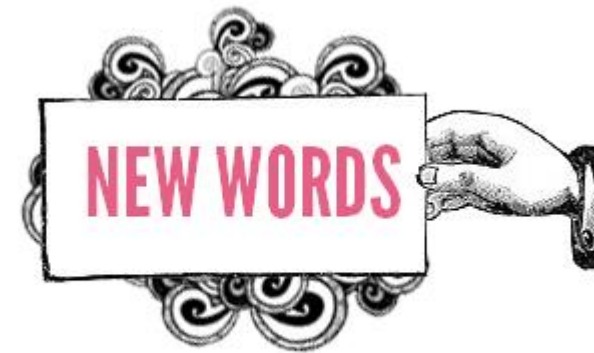
- 2 spellings from the words in the list
- 4 synonym / phrase replacement questions
- 2 of the words will need to be written *correctly* within a sentence.

Your rewards will be:

- 8/8 = 3 signatures
- 7/8 = 2 signatures
- 6/8 = 1 signature

If you receive FULL marks in each of the 10 tests, then you will receive 15 signatures!
