We wish to offer your child the chance to take part in this training **FREE of charge on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> & Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019.**

Bikeability is the "cycling proficiency" for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, designed to give the next generation the skills and confidence to ride their bikes more often on today's roads. This is a national scheme funded by the Department for Transport which the county council supports and provides to your school.

During Level 2 on-road training, outcomes for trainees include a comprehensive knowledge of correct positioning, signalling, negotiate a variety of junctions, and understand the Highway Code and road signs.
