Advice to All Parents - Single case

Dear Parents,

We have been advised by Public Health England that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the school. **This was identified as a result of lateral flow tests carried out yesterday.**

Contact Tracing

From the Autumn term, NHS Test & Trace are now responsible for contact tracing of all positive cases. If your child or young person tests positive for COVID-19, you should still inform your educational setting, however contact tracing will then be conducted by NHS Test & Trace. Those under the age of 18 and 6 months are no longer advised to isolate if they are identified as a close contact of a COVID-19 case. The guidance states they should take a PCR test. If the PCR result is positive, the individual will then be required to self-isolate.

What to do if your child develops symptoms of COVID 19

If your child develops symptoms they should not come to school until they have had a negative PCR test. If the test is positive then your child will be required to self isolate for 10 days. If they are well enough they will be able to access learning via Google Classrooms.
