Dear Parent/Guardian

**Your child is due their vaccination to protect against Human Papilloma Virus (HPV). This is offered in year 8 as part of the national immunisation programme and is free on the NHS.**

**This vaccine requires two doses; the second dose is given 6 - 24 months after the first. If your child is immunosuppressed they will require 3 doses, the team will advise you of the dates the 3 doses are required.**
